Memo to: Consumers and Direct Service Workers

Re: Change in Payroll Processing to Bi-Weekly Paychecks

Effective January 1, 2021, Payroll will be processed bi-weekly. This makes it easier to track your weekly hours and stay in compliance with your plan of care. **Direct service workers will be paid every other Friday.**

To get us to this point, you have TWO shortened pay periods this month. *Hours worked within the plan of care AND clocked in/out thru AuthentiCare between Dec 16th and 26th will get paid December 31st. Any paper timesheets submitted for this timeframe will be processed with the January 8th payroll.*
